Pakistan is where every global issue that matters to Americans most in the 21st century comes together in an extraordinary and combustible way. From al-Qaeda and terrorism to the risk of nuclear war and proliferation, Pakistan is the country most central to preventing the nightmares of our time from exploding out of control. Bruce Riedel has been senior fellow for the Saban Center for Middle East Policy at The Brookings Institution since 2006. He has been an adviser to Barack

Obama on south Asia and terrorism since April 2007. He is author of *The Search for al-Qaeda: Its Leadership, Ideology and the Future* (September 2008.)

Former CIA officer and senior adviser on the Middle East to three U.S. presidents, Bruce Riedel is the recipient of the Secretary of Defense Distinguished Service Medal (1997), the Distinguished Intelligence Medal (2001), and the State Department Meritorious Honor Award (2006). He is an alumnus of Brown and Harvard Universities, and is often quoted by major news media regarding Pakistan and al-Qaeda.
